## William Hubbard Profiled for his Quest for Global Justice

Over the span of his career, he has been awarded two of South Carolina's highest accolades — an Honorary Doctor of Laws from USC and the Order of the Palmetto, the highest civilian award given by the state's governor. Now, Hubbard practices complex business litigation and chairs the Board of Directors of The World Justice Project, an organization meant to strengthen the rule of law worldwide.

In reflecting on the Firm's growth, Hubbard told Columbia Metropolitan that he's proud to have played a part. "Our firm hired a number of people who have turned out to be really good lawyers and leaders for the firm, leaders in the community, and leaders at the bar," he said.
